

My LITTLE Montessori DOLLS

A fun game to learn how to understand a task and complete it. Play with the cute dolls and recognise which clothes go with each occasion.

THE EIGHT SCENES

The eight cards in the game depict eight dolls in eight different places and contexts. The game is a useful way to help children become familiar with the places or scenes shown on the cards, learn the associated names and also assimilate extra information about them. Little ones will enjoy slotting the cards together and inserting them into their matching shapes.



LOTTO GAME

Using the material provided, you can set up a lotto game. Split the cards equally between two or more players. Lay all the shapes face-down on the table (or place in a bag) and each player takes a turn to pick one. If the shape fits the drawing on their card, they can slot it in. If it doesn't, the next player takes a turn. The first person to complete the picture on their card wins. This game is a good way to reinforce learning in a fun group context, playing by the rules and interacting with others.
